The South Shore Chamber Inc as Service Provider for Special Service Area #42 contracted with Cleanstreet for Power washing on 71<sup>st</sup> Street in 2008.

The streets are the best they've ever been with the improved services that Cleanstreet, provided.

The equipment utilized included a high power directional wand and brush. This machine also had a 1" adjustable stainless steel guard which guaranteed an efficient cleaning. The machine delivered 5.0 gallons of water and solution per minute at 5000 PSI's. The chemical used was a biodegradable non-caustic cleaner which is safe for the sidewalk and the environment.


The cleaner was effective in removing gum, candy, melted ice cream, etc. from the sidewalk. Because the streets had never been power washed, some areas will require repeated services next year.
